

Immunization Requirements

In addition to immunizations against polio and measles, the State of California requires immunizations against Hepatitis B and diphtheria / tetanus / pertussis (DTP) for all children when they enter school.

New students must provide a completed “Report of Health Examination” and “Immunization Record” (copy) form.

Kindergarten and ECEC students must provide a completed “Report of Health Examination” or “Physician’s Report” which must include varicella (chickenpox) immunization or proof of immunity.

Students entering grade one must have a complete health screening as required by law. This health-screening requirement may be filled when entering Kindergarten since the screening is valid for eighteen (18) months.

7th grade students must provide copy of immunization records showing immunizations needed. (3 Hepatitis B, 2nd MMR and Td booster) Because Hepatitis B shots must be spaced several months apart, it is important to have preteens start the series in a timely manner.

The State of California also requires varicella (chickenpox) immunization or proof of immunity for students transferring from out of state.

Enrollment will not be finalized until all immunization requirements and records are satisfied and filed.
